ADMINISTRATION:

Mr. Lubin updated the Authority on the following items:

A stormwater fee appeal was received, reviewed and denied by Authority Secretary, Robert Firek. The resident has 30 days to submit written notice to appeal the denial.

Mrs. Conley asked if this is a commercial or residential account. Mr. Lubin replied that it is residential.

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ENGINEER:

Mr. Stanton provided his report with the following updates to the Authority:

- The Pond Retrofit contract was awarded to Independent Enterprises.
- Work on Breckenridge Pond No. 2 retrofits is underway.
- We are awaiting DEP permits for stream restoration projects for Elm Leaf Park and Glass Run Rd. The final right of way (Cemetery property off of Joseph St.) is in the approval process within the Catholic Diocese.
- Two (2) \$300,000 DEP Grant applications have been submitted for the stream restoration program.
- Elected official MS4 training was conducted at the May 10, 2022 Council meeting.
- Staff MS4 training will be conducted in July or August.
- The state has not confirmed if the current MS4 permit will auto-renew or a renewal application will be needed.
