

BALDWIN BOROUGH

As a valued customer of Waste Management, you now enjoy single-stream recycling. All of your recyclables can be placed together in the same bin – no sorting required.

Please follow these recycling guidelines:

- REGULAR CURBSIDE COLLECTION:** Garbage and refuse should be placed at the curb the night before your scheduled pick-up.
- GUIDELINES FOR COLLECTION:**
 - Garbage should be in properly secured containers or plastic bags.
 - All furniture items, appliances, household goods and disassembled children's swing sets will be accepted at curbside.
 - Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches so that one man can lift.
 - Empty paint cans and/or dried paint is acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off.
- EXCLUDED ITEMS:**
 - Building material may be picked up for a fee by calling **Waste Management** at 1-800-866-4460
 - Tires
 - Automobile parts including wheel rims.
 - Trees and branches.
 - Ashes from furnaces and fireplaces.
 - Stones and dirt, liquid paint.
- RECYCLING:** Recyclables should be placed loose in a single container.
SINGLE STREAM RECYCLE: Residents do not have to separate the plastics - type I through 7, metals, glass and papers.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Metal:** Metal food cans, aerosol cans (empty), aluminum foil and foil products (clean), beer and soft drink cans
- Plastic:** Plastic baby wipe containers, bleach, detergent, household cleaner bottles, yogurt cups, Food containers, margarine tubs, shampoo bottles
- Glass:** Beverage bottles and food jars (clear, brown, amber and green)
- Paper:** Paperboard boxes (cereal, tissue, shoes, etc.), white office paper, computer paper, magazines, newspapers, advertising inserts, junk mail (including envelopes), catalogs, phone books, paperback books, coupons and receipts, paper bags and shopping bags (handles removed), corrugated, *note: corrugated must be tied or bundled and no fin longer than 14" x 14"*.

Recyclables will be picked up every other week on your regular garbage pick-up day, The municipality will be divided into two sections, ■ and ■. Please refer to the street listing (on reverse) to be sure when service will be provided and refer to the calendar below.

- HOLIDAY SERVICE:** if a holiday falls on a Monday through Friday, pickup for the rest of the week will be one day later than the usual day. **Observed holidays for 2017 are: New Years Day, Memorial Day, JULY 4TH, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.** If the holiday should fall on a weekend, your pick up day will not be affected.

6. APPLIANCES CONTAINING REFRIGERANT:

The contractor will collect such items as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers, etc.: however, the item must have a sticker certifying that the refrigerant has been removed. If it does not have the sticker, it will not be picked up because it is unlawful for the contractor to dispose of these items containing refrigerant. To save refrigerant removal costs, it is suggested that residents have the company delivering the new appliance dispose of the old appliance.

7. BACK DOOR SERVICE IS AVAILABLE TO ALL RESIDENTS FOR A FEE OF: \$18.78 PER QTR.

This is for those residents who are unable to get their trash to the curbside for pick up and explain the service and fees?

Home Collection Program for Household Generated Special Materials

As part of the residential solid waste and recycling contract with Waste Management, effective January 1, 2016, you have a convenient new opportunity to dispose of your household generated special materials- safely, easily and responsibly. Introducing the At Your Door Special CollectionSM program, a residential service offered by Waste Management to provide year-round collections for you.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. To Participate, you must set up a collection appointment.

There are three ways to schedule a collection:

- Email AtYourDoor@WM.com

The Call Center operators will guide you through the steps toward a safe and successful collection. You will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of materials available for the pick up. You will be provided a convenient collection date and information about where to place the kit for collection. A kit will be sent to your home in plenty of time for you to gather and pack your materials.

2. Preparing for collection

The collection kit includes an instruction sheet and other items to help pack and secure your household generated special materials. Please read the instruction sheet included in the kit.

3. Material is collected

On the scheduled date, the customer service technician will collect materials directly from your home. They will sort and pack the materials for proper transportation, recycling and disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail back to help track the program.

4. You have more material than will fit into the Kit?

Remember, this service is available year-round. Just schedule another collection! Small quantities may be combined with your neighbors. Managing Household Hazardous Waste: The best method of managing Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is to prevent its generation in the first place. This involves selecting the least toxic item "to do the job" and buying only the minimum amounts necessary. Buying in large quantities is not a bargain if half of it has to be discarded. In the future, please consider buying environmentally friendly products.

Did You Know?

Latex paint is not a hazardous waste. It can often be donated to community groups and other organizations for re-use. Please consider this option before disposal.

Used motor oil is not hazardous, but may pollute our groundwater, waterways and soil if not properly managed. Many automotive station, auto parts and supply stores will accept used motor oil for recycling.

Automotive batteries may be exchanged at the place of purchase. Many battery retailers offer recycling even if you are not purchasing a new battery. In some cases, there may be a charge. Some scrap yards will also purchase lead acid batteries.
